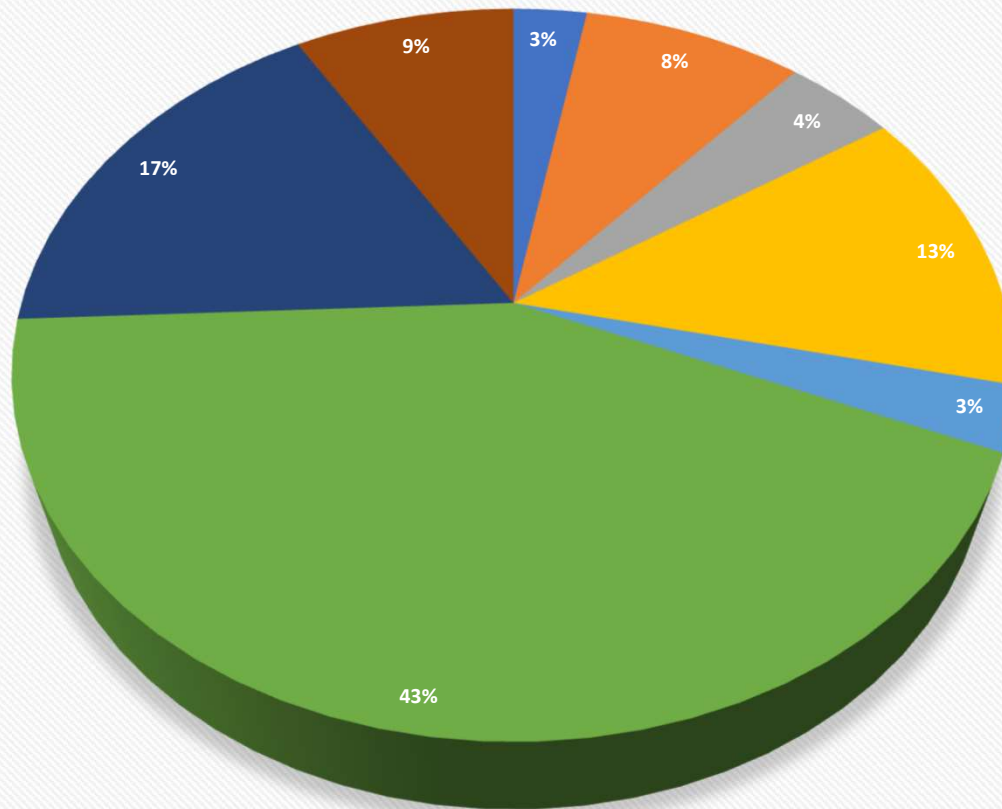
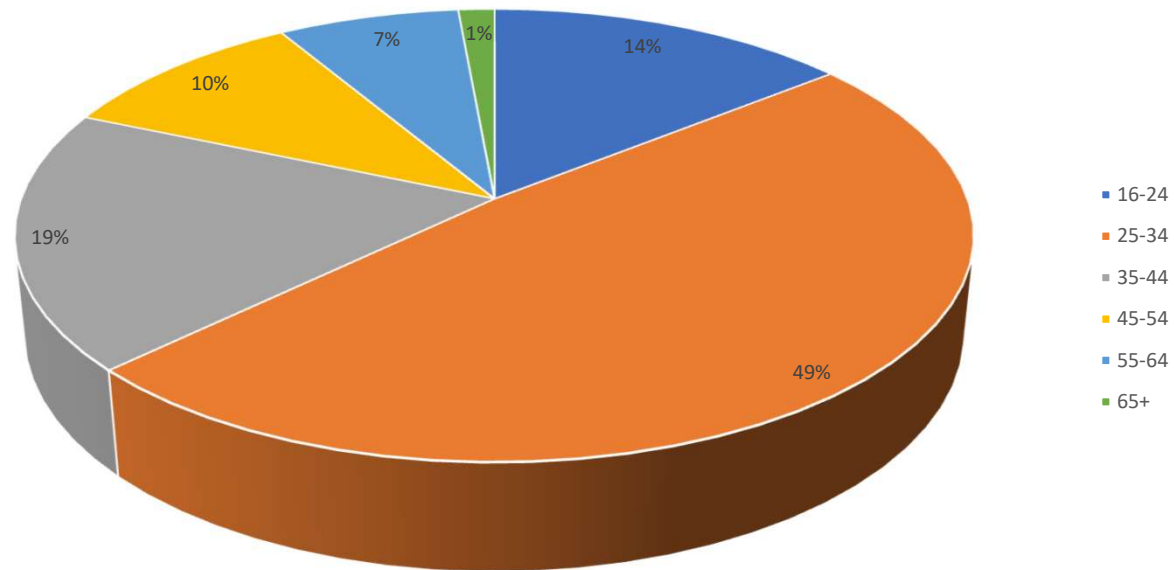


Role Categories

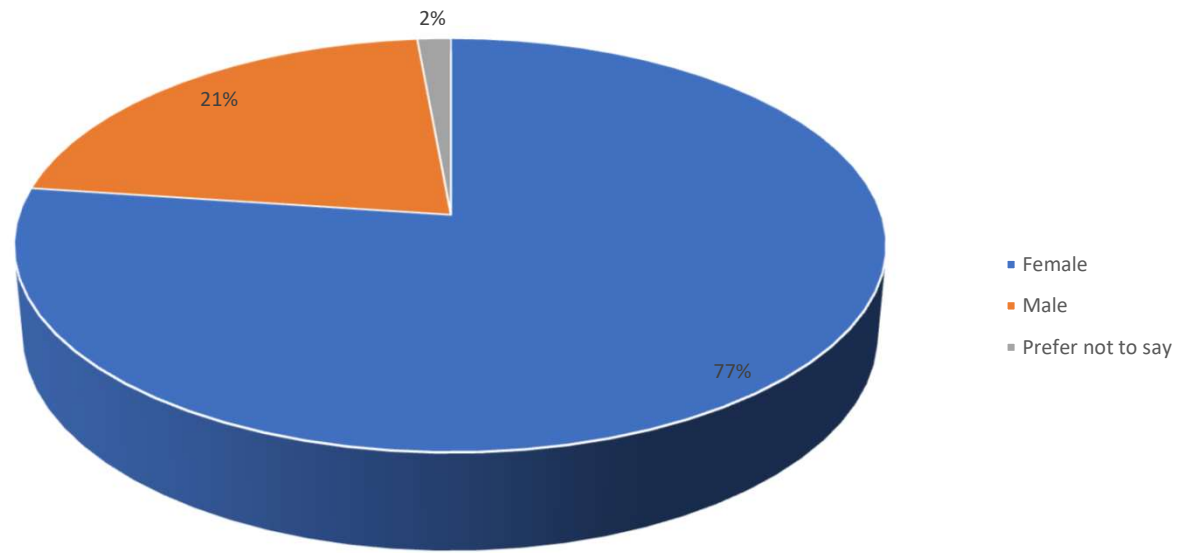


- Chartered Legal Executive (Fellow)/CILEx Practitioner - People who are authorised by CILEx Regulation.
- IT/HR/other corporate services role - Not an authorised person and not individuals in a managerial role - includes finance and accountancy roles.
- Managerial Role - Includes non-lawyer managers, directors, or members and other such as practice managers, finance or account managers ect.
- Other Fee Earning role - Includes fee earners such as trainee solicitors, members of CILEx who are not Chartered Legal Executives (Fellows) or CILEx Practitioners and paralegals i.e. those who are not 'authorised persons'.
- Prefer not to say
- Role directly supporting a fee earner - Includes legal secretaries, administrators, legal assistants, or non-fee earning paralegals
- Solicitor (Not partner) - All other practising solicitors including assistant solicitors, associates or consultants.
- Solicitor Partner (Sole practitioner, member or director) - Members or directors who are not solicitors should be recorded in the "Managerial role" category below.

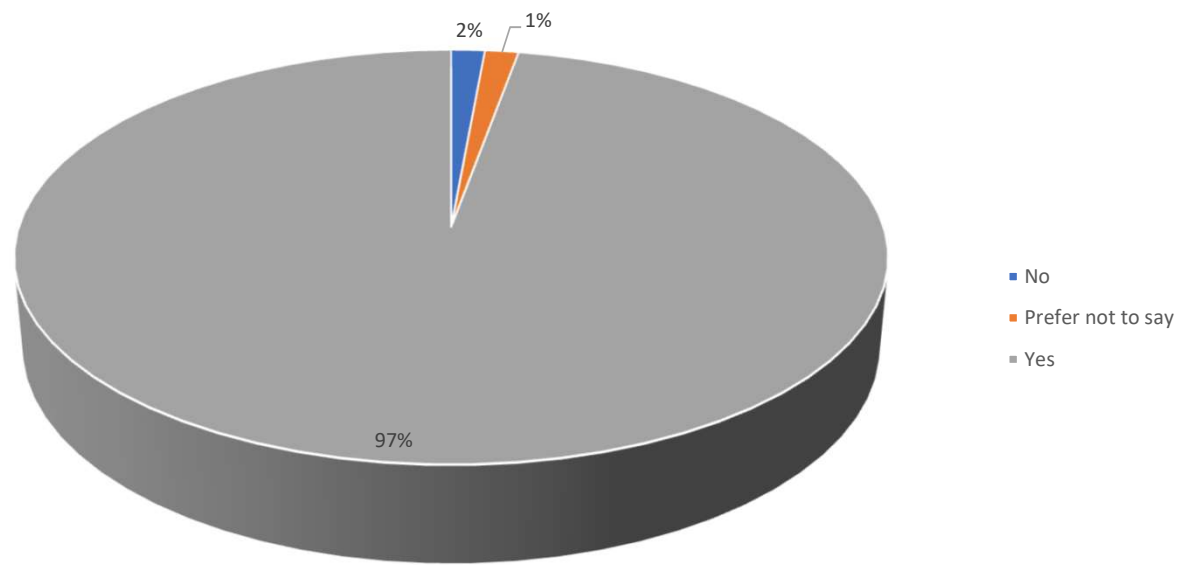

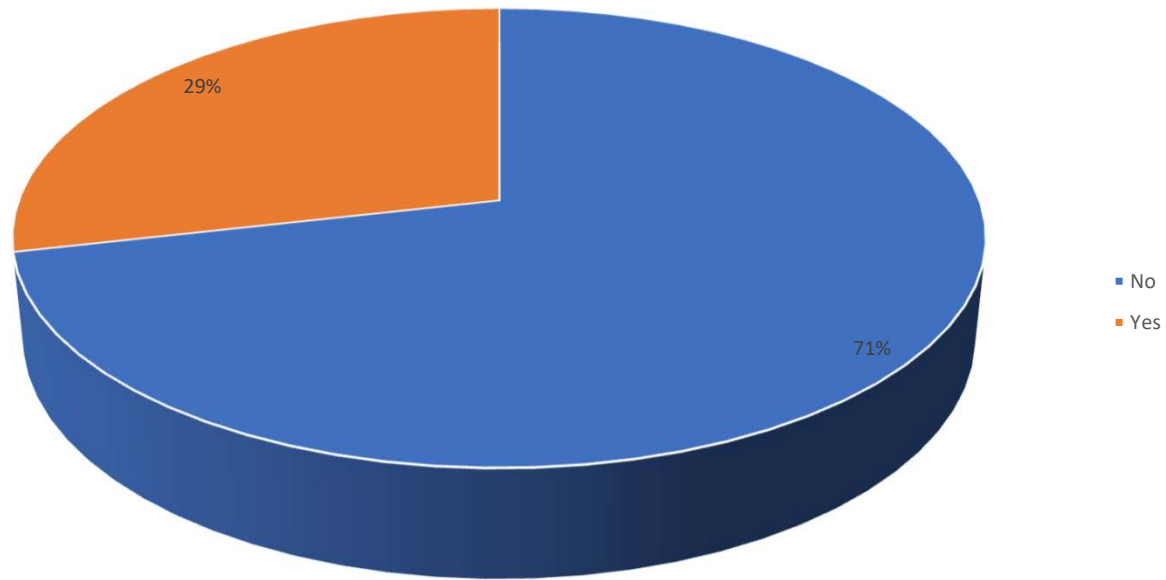
